Campers always have access to water that they can stand in during snorkeling camps. Snorkeling experience is not required for camps that have snorkeling activities. Gain hands-on experience working with mock samples to understand pathology, and discover how our Animal Health Team collects samples during husbandry sessions. You'll also embark on four exciting snorkeling trips in our local estuary, searching for dolphins in Clearwater Bay. Collaborate with your team to treat a "patient" and recommend the best course of action, just like our veterinary team! Please note that campers will not have any direct physical contact with live resident, rescue, or rehabilitation animals for the safety of both campers and animals.

COMPLETED 6TH - 8TH GRADE

(Ages 12 - 14)

ECOSYSTEM ADVOCATES Join us for an exciting full-day adventure exploring Florida's diverse coastal ecosystems while immersing yourself in hands-on learning experiences alongside the next generation of conservationists! Discover the principles of ecology as you explore mangrove habitats on a guided kayaking trip (no experience necessary) and explore an estuary ecosystem while on one snorkeling trip. Participate in three engaging field trips to witness the beauty of coastal ecosystems firsthand and learn how to make environmentally conscious choices. Get ready to apply your newfound ecological knowledge and advocate for the environment as you explore the rich biodiversity that Florida has to offer!

Participants will embark on two kayaking (no experience necessary) and two snorkeling excursions to learn first-hand about the local estuary. Please note that campers will not have any direct physical contact with live resident, rescue, or rehabilitation animals for camper and animal safety.

Dive into the vital work of the Clearwater Marine Aquarium Research Institute as you learn about data collection and how scientists utilize data to protect our environment. Enjoy a kayaking excursion (no experience necessary) and a snorkeling trip to practice field sampling methods used in estuary environments. Experience three exciting field trips to discover the tools employed in scientific studies across various ecosystems in Florida!

2025 CAMP TIMES

- Each camp is a 5-day program, scheduled Monday through Friday of the chosen week.
- Morning camp sessions operate from 8:30 am to 11:30 am.
- Afternoon camp sessions run from 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm.
- For a full-day camp experience, you have the option to purchase both morning and afternoon sessions in the same week (8:30 am to 4:00 pm).
- Advanced Marine Biology, Ecosystem Advocates, Field Investigation, and Animal Care 101 are full-day camps, running from 8:30 am to 4:00 pm.

2025 CAMP PRICES

Prices vary by camp and can be found under each camp description. Camp discount pricing for active members is not applicable to the "Ambassador, Individual, and Ocean Explorer" Membership Levels. To receive the camp discount, make sure you are signed into your CMA member account when registering. The discount will automatically apply if your membership level qualifies. Please note that you must be an active member at the time of registration; discounts cannot be applied retroactively if you become a member after registering for camp.

GENERAL REGISTRATION GUIDELINES

- Space is limited, and camps fill up quickly. Register for summer camps online at cmaquarium.org.
- No email, in-person, or phone reservations will be accepted.
- CMA's Marine Science Camp and Marine Academy Camp are designed for participants aged 5 to 18. To join, campers must be a minimum of 5 years old, have completed Kindergarten, and be no older than 18, currently in high school or having graduated within the most recent semester when their camp begins. For Advanced Marine Biology, campers must be 15 by the day their camp begins. Age verification may be requested prior to the first day of camp.
- Campers should be registered for a grade-level specific camp based on the grade level completed during the 2024-2025 school year. Clearwater Marine Aquarium reserves the right to cancel or alter reservations for campers registered inaccurately into a grade-level specific camp.
- During the enrollment process, complete the registration form in full.
- A receipt will be emailed upon completing your reservation. Save and print the receipt to bring it with you on the first day of camp.





DATE CHANGE POLICY

Date changes will be considered on a case-by-case basis upon receiving a written request via email to the Supervisor of Conservation Education Programs at camps@cmaquarium.org. Date changes are subject to availability and may require approval from Clearwater Marine Aquarium's Education management.

The new camp date must have open spots. The easiest way to secure your date change is to book the new camp date on our website, then email the confirmation (including the transaction numbers) for both the camp you're canceling and the one you're switching to camps@cmaquarium.org. We will fully refund the camp you cannot attend.

If you'd prefer to transfer your registration without waiting for a refund, email us the transaction number for the camp you're canceling and the details of the camp you wish to move to (which must have available spots). We will process the switch and send you a modified confirmation.

For all other cancellations, please refer to our camp cancellation refund policy.

CAMP GEAR PACKS

Don't have what you need for your Summer Camp Adventure? We do! Camp Gear Packs are available for purchase when registering for camps online or Monday morning at check-in. Camp Gear Packs include a CMA bag, mask, snorkel, CMA towel, CMA water bottle, sunglasses, and sunscreen*.

Campers must provide their own closed-toe water shoes. Water shoes are extremely important as shells and other items located on the bottom of Clearwater Bay may be sharp and hazardous during snorkeling. Campers may not snorkel without closed-toe water shoes at camp.

Lunches can be purchased for an additional \$40+ tax for the week for campers who are enrolled in both the morning and afternoon session or mid-day extended care. Lunches must be purchased for the entire week; single day purchases are not available. Campers should also bring a refillable water bottle and two snacks. Campers are also welcome to pack their own lunch. Please note that there is no refrigeration or microwave oven available; do not send items that are highly perishable or require heating.

MID-DAY EXTENDED CARE

Mid-day Extended Care is supervised time available to those parents who need a late pick-up after morning camp or an early drop-off for afternoon camp sessions. Mid-day Extended Care provides an opportunity for campers to rehydrate, fuel up, and eat lunch. Mid-day extended care is included for campers who are enrolled in a morning and afternoon session of camp.



REFUND POLICY

Refunds on camp payments will be processed once written notification has been submitted by emailing the Supervisor of Conservation Education Programs at **camps@cmaquarium.org**. In the event of a cancellation, an 80% refund will be issued if the written cancellation request is received 15 days or more before the first day of camp. Cancellations within 14 to 5 days prior to the camp start will receive a partial refund of 50% of the total cost. Cancellations 4-0 days prior to the camp start will NOT receive a refund.

Full or partial refunds will NOT be issued to summer campers who attend one or more days of camp. Make-up days will not be offered for absences from camp.

Clearwater Marine Aquarium reserves the right to separate or combine camps. Clearwater Marine Aquarium also reserves the right to cancel a camp for any reason. If your camp is canceled, you will be contacted a minimum of three 3 days in advance.

We require a minimum of three (3) participants per camp session. If we do not meet the minimum required participants by the Wednesday prior the camp, the camp will be canceled and full refunds, or rescheduling, will be conducted.

INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY

Florida is prone to thunderstorms, tropical storms, red tide, and even hurricanes. There may be times when normal camp schedules need to be altered due to inclement weather or unsafe water conditions, such as extremely high tides rendering the water unsuitable for snorkeling. In these instances, Clearwater Marine Aquarium has indoor classroom activities planned for campers. For camps which include snorkeling, traveling, kayaking, or any other outdoor activities (including animal encounters), we will adjust our outdoor schedules in the event of inclement weather or water conditions for the safety of our campers. We will make every effort to resume normal camp schedules on inclement weather days as soon as possible. Since Clearwater Marine Aquarium does not have control over inclement weather or water conditions, we cannot guarantee that campers scheduled in these camps will snorkel, travel, kayak, or participate in an outdoor activity every day. Therefore, we will not issue full or partial refunds due to inclement weather.

In the event of a hurricane or other event in which the Aquarium may be subject to closure, please check **cmaquarium.org** for information on camp operation.



CAMP SAFETY

We continue to evolve our protocols as we receive information and recommendations from governmental agencies that include, but are not limited to, Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, Pinellas County Government, and the Florida Department of Health. Protocols and planned camp schedules are subject to change based on current recommendations. For your camper's safety, camp staff will only release your child to an authorized pick-up person with a valid photo ID at sign-out. Authorized pick-ups are provided during registration. If your child will be picked up by someone not provided during the initial registration, you will need to notify Clearwater Marine Aquarium staff in person during check-in or by emailing camps@cmaquarium.org. If you fail to notify staff prior to pick up, there may be a delay as Education staff will need to contact the authorized parents/guardians to confirm authorization.

In addition, all persons, bags, parcels, and other items may be subject to screening/security checks upon arrival at camp. No weapons of any kind, bicycles, skateboards, recreational scooters, skates, glass containers, or balloons are permitted at CMA for the safety of our guests, animals, and staff. For a full list of prohibited items and activities, please visit our Aquarium Rules page. Campers are encouraged to bring clear bags in order to reduce wait times during check-in.

BOAT & KAYAK SAFETY

As per the United States Coast Guard, life jackets are not mandatory on Clearwater Marine Aquarium vessels, but they are available for camps with snorkeling and boating activities. Snorkeling vests will be provided to each camper, and if you prefer your camper to wear a life jacket during snorkeling, kindly inform the camp teacher during sign-in. Our camp boats adhere to Coast Guard certification, equipped with railings and essential safety features. Clearwater Marine Aquarium staff are trained in first aid and CPR. For snorkeling camps, campers will always have access to standing water, and prior snorkeling experience is not required.

During kayaking sessions, our Camp Teachers deliver instruction on basic kayaking techniques and equipment to summer campers. Our priority is to create a supportive and enjoyable environment on the water. For safety, all kayakers are mandated to wear life jackets throughout the activity.
